How to make a bar graph of species seen in different habitats - manually

- 1. List the habitat codes across the white board
- 2. List the species seen under the appropriate habitats
- 3. Total the number of species
- 4. Draw the "x" and "y" lines
- 5. Put a "0" at the bottom, "1", "2" etc. up the "y" axis (vertical)
- 6. Put the habitat codes along the "x" axis (horizontal)
- 7. Draw a rectangle from the "x" axis to the correct number on the "y" axis
- 8. Repeat for each habitat
- 9. Label the "x" axis "Habitat Code"
- 10. Label the "y" axis "How Many" or "Quantity"
- 11. Explain what the graph is showing
